

# **Questions and Answers**

Q: The cost per person is \$75 and includes both the Happy Hour Friday night at the Burrstone Inn, and the main dinner Saturday night at Harts Hill Inn. What is the cost if I can only make it Friday night, or just Saturday night?

A: The cost of a ticket is \$75. This ticket entitles you to admission to Friday's event and Saturday's event. The \$75 ticket would also be good for either Friday or Saturday. We strongly encourage you to plan to attend both events. There is no reduced price for just Friday, or just Saturday.

Q: I am a class of 1974 graduate and would like to bring a friend that graduated in a different class year. Can I bring a friend?

A: Yes! They could also register and attend with a paid \$75 admission.

### Q: Is there a block of Hotel rooms reserved for classmates from out of town?

A: Yes. We have 15 rooms reserved at the Burrstone Inn on Burrstone Rd. In New York Mills. The reduced cost is \$159, plus tax. They are located at 1777 Burrstone Rd in New York Mills. Their number is 315-797-2131. Once the 15 rooms are booked, additional rooms may be available but the hotel did warn us that summer is their busy season. So we recommend booking a room early. Also, the Happy Hour Friday night will be held in the bar area of the Burrstone Inn. So guests would not have to drive home after the Happy Hour!

## Q: Will there be entertainment Friday and Saturday night?

A: Yes there will on both nights! We have an excellent band, *Mallory Road*, performing from 4:30pm until 6:30pm Friday. This will be followed by karaoke from 7:00pm until 9:00pm. Saturday night we have the duo, *Two of Us*. They are an awesome local pair that will be playing several popular hits! Also Saturday night, roving magician *Jim Lutz* will entertain you at your table!

### Q: If I come for the weekend, what are some things to do during the day Saturday?

A: We have several activities recommended for Saturday morning and afternoon. Starting with a guided tour of the Whitesboro Senior High at 10:00am. There will also be activities available at several of the top local Utica attractions. These will be informal events that you can attend based on your interest. Each attraction will have a Reunion Committee member acting as the Ambassador (see below). They can help you with times, directions, and to answer any questions you may have. We figured this would be a great way for you to meet up with those long lost classmates, many of whom you haven't seen in 50 years! Below are the attractions and Ambassadors, along with their contact information. The cost for most of these attractions will be free. There would be additional minimal out of pocket costs for things like drinks (where available) or food. Obviously golf would have green fees and carts as an individual expense. The Brewery Tour has a \$10 fee.

Q: Why would I want to visit The Irish Cultural Center, or the Nexus Center @ The Utica Auditorium or The Saranac Brewery during the day on Saturday, 8-24-24?

A: We made arrangements for some fun things to do during the day Saturday. It starts with a tour of the Whitesboro Sr. High at 10:00am. This will give you a chance to stir up old memories as you enter the pit, or stroll down Warrior Hall.

The Irish Cultural Center has a beautiful bar that was hand crafted in Ireland and shipped to Utica where it was assembled showing the great craftsmanship of the Irish woodworkers. Our classmate, Tom Sullivan, and his brothers, were the builders of the Irish Cultural Center. Tom and his brother Jim did all the outside stonework. The Cultural Center is a treasure in Utica. There is also a historical section at the Center that will allow you to see some of the accomplishments of the Irish.

The Nexus Center, newly built next to the existing Utica Auditorium, has three professional regulation ice rinks that are used to host hockey tournaments throughout the year. It is home to the Women's World Hockey Tournament held in Utica in April 2024. It is also home to AHL members, The Utica Comets, and Utica University also has a men's and women's team that play here. These rinks are also used for Soccer and Lacrosse games. There are two bars/restaurants in the Nexus Center. And....it is very cool inside on a hot August day!

The Saranac Brewery (Utica Club) needs no introduction to the class of 1974. The brewery has been a staple in the Utica area since its origin in 1888. Most, if not all of you, have likely taken the Utica Club Brewery tour at one point or another. Do you remember Matt's beer balls from our high school days? Or Maximus Super beer? Here is your chance to again see the pride of Utica up close and personal, including their expanded gift shop where you are sure to find a souvenir worthy of a trip home with you. They now also have an outdoor Beer Garden where you can relax and have a lunch. There is a \$10 fee to take the brewery tour.

## Q:Why is there a separate charge for the Brewery VIP tour and what does that cover?

A: Our reunion group is getting accommodation for an early start time at 12 noon for up to 25 people. The regular rate is \$20 per person but if we stay for lunch the rate is reduced to \$10 per person. The \$10 tour includes a four-beer sampler but not the lunch, where everyone will order separately from the lunch menu.

# Q: What is the suggested attire for the Friday happy hour and the dinner Saturday?

A: One thing that hasn't changed is August often being hot and muggy! The Happy Hour Friday will be casual. Shorts, golf shirts, sun dresses, or anything else casual is acceptable. Saturday's dinner at Hart's Hill Inn, is more business casual.
